

## Weill Cornell Policy on Exhibits at Continuing Medical Education Activities

- 1. Exhibits associated with CME activities must be disclosed on CME applications and approved by the Weill Cornell CME Committee. The budget for any exhibits must be disclosed on this application.
- 2. Arrangements for commercial exhibits or advertisements cannot influence the planning or interfere with the presentation of CME activities, nor can they be a condition of the provision of commercial support for CME activities.
- 3. Exhibits must be placed in a space separate from the educational activity space. This space must not be on an obligatory path to the educational activity.
- 4. A separate contract must be used for exhibit arrangements and approved by the CME Committee. That contract will contain the terms, conditions, and prohibitions regarding exhibits associated with the education activity.
- 5. Exhibit income will be accounted for separately from commercial support income and will be disclosed on all CME application materials.
- 6. A list of exhibitors will be provided to the CME Committee in order for them to assess any potential conflict of interest in this activity.
