

Weill Cornell Office of CME Social Event Policy and Guidelines

Social events that are part of Weill Cornell CME activities may provide a relaxed, informal atmosphere that allows for interaction among the participants and the faculty members. In order to provide such an atmosphere and to comply with Weill Cornell, ACCME and AMA standards, adherence to the following guidelines is required:

1. Social events associated with CME activities must be disclosed on CME applications and approved by the Weill Cornell CME Committee. The budget for these activities must be included in this application.
2. Social events funded directly by Industry Supporters are prohibited for all Weill Cornell CME activities.
3. The total cost for all social events must not exceed \$100 per day per participant.
4. The combined duration of any social event(s) must be less than the duration of the educational activity.
5. The nature of any social event(s) must allow for interaction among participants and faculty members. (e.g. Theatrical performance and sporting events would not be in compliance).
6. The social event(s) must not compete with, or take precedence over, the educational activity, or in the brochures, programs or promotion of the activity.

The CME Committee reserves the right to limit or deny approval for Weill Cornell social events associated with CME activities.
