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FACULTY DISCLOSURE POLICY FOR CME ACTIVITIES

FORM #CMEG-3

As a Continuing Medical Education provider accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME), Weill Medical College of Cornell University requires that prospective participants in CME activities be informed of faculty members' affiliations with or financial interest in organizations that financially support or have a direct interest in the subject matter of a continuing medical education presentation.

All CME faculty are required to read Weill Cornell's CME Faculty Disclosure Guidelines and to complete a Weill-Cornell-CME Faculty Disclosure Form. The prospective audience shall be made aware of what might be construed as a conflict of interest by an acknowledgement in the program *and/or* verbal presentation of the faculty member. In addition, all off label uses or investigated treatments will be disclosed.

For example:

Professor, Department of Medicine
Weill Medical College of Cornell University
New York, NY
Research Consultant--A.B.C. Pharmaceuticals, New York, NY
Intends to discuss the off label use of medications/treatments

or if Dr. Doe has a financial interest:

J. Doe, M.D.
Professor, Department of Medicine
Weill Medical College of Cornell University
New York, NY
Stockholder, A.B.C. Pharmaceuticals, New York, NY
Does NOT intend to discuss the off label use of medications/treatments

The intent of this policy is not to prevent a speaker with a conflict of interest from making a presentation. Rather, it is to identify openly any potential or apparent conflict so that the participant may form his/her own judgement about the presentation.
