| | Write personal statement following the prompt: A one-page essay outlining something about yourself, how you developed an interest in a medical career, and your interest in working with underserved populations. |
| | Ask individuals from the following prompt if they could write a good letter of recommendation for you: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Letter of Recommendation #1: A letter from your college premedical advisor or one member of your science faculty who has taught you, and who will give us a statement of your motivation and potential for medical and scientific studies.2. Letter of Recommendation #2: A letter of recommendation from a source outside of your college community where you have worked on issues with underserved populations within the USA. |
